## *A Brief History of DKA*

DELTA KAPPA ALPHA was first organized in 1935, receiving its National Charter in 1936 at the University of Southern California. Alpha Chapter was immediately founded at SC, to be followed within a few years by chapters at NYU and Boston. Other colleges have expressed an interest in DKA, and it is probable that as many as ten chapters may be functioning by 1960. DKA alumni members are all over the United States, Asia, and Europe today.

THE FRATERNITY was founded to further the art of Cinema and to promote better relations between members and the industry. Delta Kappa Alpha represents the three basic arts of the cinema—*dramatic, kinematic, and aesthetic.*
