A BRIEF HISTORY OF DELTA KAPPA ALPHA

Delta Kappa Alpha was first organized in 1935, receiving its National Charter in 1936 at the University of Southern California. Alpha Chapter began functioning immediately at SC, followed by Beta Chapter at Boston University in 1949, Gamma Chapter at NYU in 1950 and Delta Chapter at UCLA in 1953. DKA alumni are scattered all over the Americas, Asia and Europe today.

The Fraternity was founded to further the art of Cinema and to promote better relations between members and the industry, both theatrical and documentary. ^{the name} Delta Kapp Alpha ^{is derived from} ~~represents~~ the three basic arts of the Cinema - Dramatic, Kinematic and Aesthetic.

The Fraternity, through the activities and fine reputation of its members and alumni in the film industry, is recognized by the industry as an outstanding organization in the academic world, one which creates and maintains a strong bond between the academic and the professional worlds.

A WORD ABOUT PLEDGING

Requirements: A candidate for entrance into Delta Kappa Alpha must evidence a keen interest in Cinema and have the intention of following a career in Cinema or a related field. He (or she) must be enrolled at the University of Southern California and be either a major in Cinema or in a related field within the Division of Communication. The applicant must have completed at least three Cinema courses, two of which are upper division (300 level or higher), with at least a 3.0 grade average in these courses.

The active members reserve the right to decide whether a candidate is, or promises to be, superior in the field of Cinema, and in no case is the fraternity obligated to accept a candidate because of a superior grade point or for any other reasons.
